Red Head Reserve Draft Plan of Management for Greater Taree City Council & Mid Coast Water, Mid North Coast

In conjunction with Council, Mid Coast Water and other community stakeholders All About Planning undertook a survey and held a workshop and has drafted a Plan of Management for this 1.2 hectare park at the end of Red Head Rd. Redhead.
